MATTER 20-01326 - In the Matter of PSEG Long Island 2021 Energy Efficiency and Demand Response Plan Review.

NOTICE REQUESTING COMMENTS

(Issued July 8, 2020)

The New York State Department of Public Service (DPS or Department) is seeking comment on PSEG Long Island's (PSEG LI) proposed 2021 Energy Efficiency and Demand Response Plan (EEDR Plan). On June 30, 2020, in accordance with the Long Island Power Authority Reform Act (LRA), PSEG LI submitted the EEDR Plan to the DPS for review and recommendation. Pursuant to the LRA, the purpose of the EEDR Plan is to implement energy efficiency measures, distributed generation, or advanced grid technology programs providing customers with tools to more efficiently and effectively manage their energy usage and utility bills, and improve system reliability and power quality.¹

Interested persons or parties are invited to submit comments on the EEDR Plan by August 24, 2020. Reply comments are requested by September 8, 2020. The EEDR Plan may be viewed on the Department's Web site at www.dps.ny.gov by searching for Matter Number 20-01326.
