ERRATA NOTICE

(Issued October 1, 2004)

The terms of the rate plan adopted by the Commission in this proceeding envisioned that the necessary gas and steam tariff changes would take effect on October 1, 2004. The Order issued September 27, 2004 authorized the tariff changes to take effect on or after October 18, 2004 on a temporary basis. Ordering Clauses 2 and 3 are corrected to allow such tariff changes to take effect on October 1, 2004 and to read as follows:

The Commission orders:

2. By not later than October 1, 2004, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. shall cancel the tariff leaves and supplements listed in the Appendix to this order.

3. The company is authorized to file immediately, to take effect on or after October 1, 2004 on a temporary basis, such further gas and steam tariff changes as are necessary to effectuate the terms of this order. The company is also authorized to file such tariff changes as are necessary to effectuate the steam rate year 2 changes as adopted by this order. The steam rate year 2

changes shall be allowed to become effective on a temporary basis on one day's notice. The company shall serve copies of its filings upon all parties to these proceedings. Any comments on the compliance filings must be received at the Commission's offices within ten days of service of the company's proposed amendments. The amendments specified in the compliance filing shall not become effective on a permanent basis until approved by the Commission and will be subject to refund if any showing is made that the revisions are not in compliance with this order.
