NOTICE REGARDING SUBMISSION OF COMMENTS

On April 21, 2016, Kenneth S. Panza requested an extension of time to file comments in response to the Notice of Proposed Rule Making (Notice) that was published in the New York State Register on March 23, 2016 in the above-referenced proceeding. The Commission is considering the Woodstock Town Board's filing allowing customers of Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation to opt out of using an Automatic Meter Reading (AMR) device by having an electro-mechanical meter installed. The Notice stated that public comments will be received until 45 days after publication of the Notice, which is May 9, 2016.
