NOTICE OF STAKEHOLDER MEETING
AND SEEKING COMMENTS

(Issued November 1, 2016)

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Department of Public Service Staff (Staff) will convene a meeting on Monday, November 7, 2016, regarding the distribution-level demand response program changes for the 2016 summer capability period required by the Commission's Order Adopting Dynamic Load Management Program Changes With Modification, (the DLM Order), issued on May 23, 2016 in the above-captioned proceeding.¹ This notice provides additional information on attending that meeting in person or by teleconference.

The meeting will be held between 10:00 A.M. and 12:00 P.M. at the New York State Department of Public Service's Albany Offices, Three Empire State Plaza, 3rd Floor Hearing Room. To join the meeting by teleconference, individuals may call (866) 776-3553 and use conference code 645053954.

The meeting will be an opportunity for stakeholders to provide feedback regarding their experiences with the DLM Programs during the 2016 summer capability period, in advance of the utilities' possible filings requesting modification to their respective DLM Programs for 2017.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Commission is seeking comments from interested entities on the following questions:

1. If you participated in any distribution-level demand response program(s) during both the 2015 and 2016 summer capability periods, did you experience any significant change in the ease of enrolling in such programs, administering such programs to your clients, or other changes that affected your ability to participate in these programs, either positive or negative?
2. What modifications would you suggest to help make your enrollment in the utilities' DLM Programs easier?
3. What modifications would you suggest to help make administering these programs to your clients easier?
4. What modifications would you suggest to further facilitate participation in these DLM programs?

Written responses are encouraged and shall be filed in Case 14-E-0423, entitled "Proceeding on Motion of the Commission to Develop Dynamic Load Management Programs," and be submitted to the Secretary by e-filing through the Department of Public Service's Document and Matter Management System (DMM),² or by e-mail to the Secretary at secretary@dps.ny.gov, no later than November 14, 2016.
