NOTICE OF PUBLIC STATEMENT HEARINGS

(Issued July 6, 2016)

The New York State Public Service Commission (Commission) invites public comment concerning the January 29, 2016 filing by National Grid, on behalf of KeySpan Gas East Corporation (KEDLI), of proposed changes in the gas delivery rates and practices of KEDLI. As updated by KEDLI in the testimony filed June 10, 2016, the proposed rate change would result in an increase in KEDLI's annual gas delivery revenues of approximately \$146 million (net of changes related to site investigation and remediation cost collections and other adjustments) beginning January 1, 2017. KEDLI's proposal represents a delivery revenue increase of about 24 percent and an overall revenue increase, factoring in commodity and delivery charges, of about 16 percent. The actual bill impacts of these proposed changes on any particular customer or customer class would vary.
