This letter and enclosure are provided as the Public Involvement Program Tracking Report for the Island Park Energy Center, which proposes a repowering of National Grid's E.F. Barrett Power Station. Submittal of this tracking report is consistent with the Public Involvement Program (PIP) Plan that was most recently submitted to the Commission on December 3, 2013.

The proposed repowering of the E.F. Barrett Power Station, if approved by the Long Island Power Authority, would result in a new modern energy center at the Barrett Station through the installation of new, state-of-the art electric generators and removal of all existing electric generating equipment currently on the site. The new energy center, which will be known as the "Island Park Energy Center", will provide a more efficient and cost-effective facility to produce electricity while minimizing impacts on the surrounding communities and providing tax benefits into the future.

The enclosed Meeting Log summarizes the actions that have already been taken with regard to the Project's Public Involvement Program and the planned future activities. National Grid has participated in a number of introductory project stakeholder meetings since the last PIP Tracking Report in January. Moreover, National Grid held a public open house for the Project on March 4, 2014 at Lincoln Oren Middle School in Island Park, NY. All public involvement meetings and activities to date are included in the attached updated Project Meeting Log.
