Dear Ms. Burgess:

The Number Three Wind Farm (the Project) is a proposed 126 MW wind and solar energy project, located in Lewis County, New York in the towns of Lowville and Harrisburg, owned and developed by Number Three Wind LLC (NTW), an affiliate of Invenergy LLC. NTW has submitted an interconnection request, and NYISO is performing an interconnection feasibility study for the Project.

Under Article 10 of the Public Service Law, the New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment (the Siting Board) requires an applicant proposing to construct a major electric generating facility to submit a Public Involvement Program (PIP) plan for review by the Department of Public Service (DPS) at least 150 days prior to filing a Preliminary Scoping Statement. Accordingly, with this letter please find the Project's preliminary PIP plan for review by the DPS.
