Informal Hearings, Shared Meter Case, Appeals and Rehearings July 2004

Informal Hearing Cases

As of July 30, 2004, there were 66 cases in the Informal Hearing Unit. During the month 6 complaints were resolved with pre-hearing mediation, 14 informal hearings were scheduled, 6 hearings were postponed, 8 hearings were held, and 4 informal hearing cases were closed with written decisions.

Shared Meter Designee Cases

Under Section 52 of PSL (Shared Meter Law) only the Commission or its Designee can decide certain complaints. The majority of these cases concern the12-month charge assessed to owners for failure to find and correct instances of shared metering. At the end of June, 161 shared meter complaints were pending. Thirty-five new complaints were received in July and 15 cases were closed.

Details about the cases closed in July follow. In a case where the utility found the shared area use to be minimal, the parties were unable to reach an agreement for the minimal shared use; therefore, the designee ordered an apportionment that was fair. The designee reduced the 12-month assessment to the minimum of 25% in 7 cases and to levels between 25% and 50% in 3 cases. The 12-month assessment billed to landlords were cancelled in 4 cases involving minimal use, extraordinary cost, or theft of service.

Appeals and Rehearings

At two sessions held during the month of July, the Commission approved OCS's recommended determinations of 4 appeal cases and 3 rehearing petitions. Two appeal determinations upheld in their entirety bills issued, by Con Edison and KeySpan–LI, to multiple-dwelling customers for unauthorized use of interruptible gas during a period of service interruption. A third appeal determination concludes that Jamestown Board of Public Utilities was not required to forfeit money to a residential customer under 16 NYCRR §11.3(c), because its actions were not shown to have actually deprived the customer of service. A fourth appeal determination upholds NYSEG's request for a security deposit from a delinquent nonresidential customer. One rehearing determination denies a customer's petition concerning a recent appeal determination. The 2 remaining rehearing determinations deny petitions from landlords served by Con Edison and by Central Hudson respectively; both petitions concerned determinations by the Commission's designee in shared meter cases.

During July, 2 appeals were accepted for review. In the first, Central Hudson appeals from an informal decision arguing that the hearing officer incorrectly concluded that a customer was served by a shared meter; in the second, a residential electric customer disputes a bill issued by Con Edison. Additionally, 2 requests were received for rehearing of decisions by the Commission's designee in shared meter cases, both involving Con Edison.
