NOTICE CONCERNING NEW CASE NUMBER
AND SOLICITING COMMENTS

(Issued July 12, 2016)

In its January 21, 2016, Order Authorizing the Clean Energy Fund Framework (the CEF Order),¹ the Commission directed the filing of a proposal for a New York Power Authority (NYPA) opt-in tariff by June 30, 2016 designed to promote greater deployment of clean energy technology around the state while avoiding inequities among ratepayers. Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid, and Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (collectively, the Joint Utilities) filed their proposal on June 30, 2016 and subsequently filed a corrected proposal on July 7, 2016 in Cases 14-M-0094 and 15-M-0252. New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation filed a separate proposal, supporting the Joint Utilities' proposal with modifications, on June 30, 2016 in Cases 14-M-0094 and 15-M-0252.
