AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made and entered into on the date when signed by the party signing last in time, by and between Granite State Electric Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Hampshire, with its principal place of business at 9 Lowell Road, Salem, New Hampshire 03079; Massachusetts Electric Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts with its principal place of business at 55 Bearfoot Road, Northborough, Massachusetts 01532; Nantucket Electric Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, with its principal place of business at 25 Research Drive, Westborough, Massachusetts 01582; The Narragansett Electric Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Rhode Island, with a principal business address of 280 Melrose Street, Providence, Rhode Island 02907; New England Power Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, with its principal place of business at 25 Research Drive, Westborough, Massachusetts, 01582; National Grid Corporate Services, LLC., a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, with its principal place of business at 175 East Old Country Road, Hicksville, New York 11801; and Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, with its principal place of business at 300 Erie Boulevard West, Syracuse, New York 13202; hereafter referred to as "Owner" and ALLAN BRITEWAY ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR'S INC. (Contractor), a Pennsylvania corporation, having its principal place of business at 160 Algonquin Parkway, Whippany, New Jersey, for the Work identified as:

OVERHEAD LIVE LINE INSPECTION PROGRAM Associated with PO #00001355192

ARTICLE 1 - SCOPE OF WORK

- 1.1 The Contractor hereby agrees to provide all materials, equipment, apparatus, tools, labor, Services, and facilities and to perform all the Work and do all things necessary to perform the work associated with overhead electric transmission, sub-transmission, and distribution line inspections using live line techniques as assigned on National Grid facilities across New York and New England, all in accordance with this Agreement.
- 1.2 Primary locales of Work prescribed will be in Upstate New York and New England. This Contact shall also be valid for Work on Long Island, as a contingency, for at the time of award no allowances are in place for Live Line activities on facilities owned by the Long Island Power Authority (LIPA).
- 1.3 The Specification for each Work action shall be as prescribed by the National Grid Line Inspection Department and or as may be applicable to the individual Work assignments and prescriptions.

ARTICLE 2 - CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

2.1 The following documents, including all attached schedules, appendices, exhibits or other

attachments thereto, are incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein, and are hereinafter referred to collectively and individually as the "Contract Documents" or the "Agreement":

- 2.2 Contractor acknowledges and agrees that by its complete acquisition of the line predecessor firm Albert Fry III aka Fry Electric, line operations services of which were purchased by Allan Briteway Electrical Contractors, in a direct transfer of terms, conditions, and pricing.
- 2.3 Contractor acknowledges and agrees that various of the aforementioned documents, procedures, assumptions, conditions, proposals, and pricing that were associated with the on-line Ariba bid event entitled "SS Live Line Services 031710" and Doc15296353 are integral with and to this Agreement.
- 2.4 Should assignments/prescriptions for Long Island Work be made relative to Article 1, paragraph 1.2 above, Contractor acknowledges that pricing and function of this Agreement shall remain valid, and that a Contract Change Order will be executed to incorporate certain contract language associated with Owner's maintenance agreement with the Long Island Power Authority, and or its assigns.

ARTICLE 3 – TERM AND SCHEDULE

- 3.1 This Agreement shall be effective for a nominal (3) three year term beginning on October 10, 2011, or when the Agreement is executed by all parties, whichever occurs last in time. It shall continue in full force until October 31, 2014, or in accordance with the Terms and Conditions 0700. At the Owner's option, the Agreement may be extended annually for two (2) additional years.
- 3.2 The Work to be performed under this Agreement shall be in accordance with the specific Work assigned as documented with Work Authorization(s), a copy of which form shall be used is incorporated herein by reference as Schedule C.
- 3.3 Any Work to be performed under this Agreement shall be commenced on the date specified in the relevant Work Authorization Form, and shall be completed in accordance with the schedule developed by the Contractor and accepted by the Owner. The Contractor shall prepare updated schedules as may be requested by the Owner and as set forth more fully in any relevant Work Authorization.

ARTICLE 4 - CONTRACT PRICE

- 4.1 This is a Unit Price, plus Time and Expenses, Blanket Contract, and is based on the units of measure, estimated quantities and unit prices quoted in response to Ariba bid event Doc15296353 by predecessor firm Albert Fry III aka Fry Electric, line operations services of which were purchased by Allan Briteway Electrical Contractors, in a direct transfer of terms, conditions, and pricing.
- 4.2 The Contract Price shall be the total price to be paid by the Owner to the Contractor in accordance with the prices set forth in Schedule D-1 and as specified in the relevant Work Authorization Forms assigning and scheduling elements of the Work.
- 4.3 Any aspect of the Work that is assigned and determined by the Owner to be out-ofscope for the units established in this Agreement shall be paid based on actual and verifiable Labor and Equipment costs as set forth in Schedule D-2, the Work Authorization Form, and Terms and Conditions of Schedule A.
- 4.4 Rates of Schedule D are fixed and firm for the first two (2) years of the contract, effective upon the date of execution of this contract. Annual rate proposals may be submitted at twelve month intervals thereafter, unless otherwise agreed to in writing by both parties.
- 4.4 No later than February 28 each year, the Contractor shall submit a written request for rate adjustment for the following National Grid fiscal year starting on April 1.
- 4.5 Work being performed under a Work Authorization issued within the term of the Agreement, whether extended or not, shall continue in force in relation to that Work until the date that the Work under the relevant Work Authorization is completed and the term of the Agreement, with respect to such Work, shall be extended accordingly.
- 4.6 The Contract Price shall be all inclusive for the Work required by this Agreement in accordance with all the Contract Documents including, but not limited to, the Terms and Conditions.

ARTICLE 5 - PAYMENTS

- 5.1 Not less than monthly the Contractor shall submit to the Owner its invoice, in a form acceptable to the Owner, for the total number of units of Work completed through the last Day of the preceding month.
- 5.2 The measurement and value of such completed Work shall be determined in accordance with each Work Authorization Form, and Schedule D, together with such supporting evidence as may be required by the Owner. The Owner will pay to the Contractor, subject to the Terms and Conditions, the amount invoiced less previous payments. The Contractor shall submit at least one invoice for each Work Authorization.
- 5.3 All invoices shall be submitted and payments made in accordance with and subject to the Terms and Conditions. Individual invoices shall be addressed as below, noting the National Grid affiliate company(ies) for whom the Work was performed, the Purchase Order Number, an appropriate Work description (e.g. Work Authorization Form number or circuit or name citation), and reference the name of the Owner's Representative monitoring the Contractor's Work performance.




