The Eight Point Wind Energy Center Project ("Project") is a proposed 103.4 MW wind energy project, located in the towns of Canisteo, Greenwood, Hartsville, Hornellsville, Jasper, Troupsburg and West Union, Steuben County, New York. The interconnection request for the Project has been submitted to NYISO and has been given queue #422.

Under Article 10 of the Public Service Law, the New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment (Siting Board) requires applicants proposing to construct a major electric generating facility to submit a Public Involvement Program (PIP) plan for review by the Department of Public Service at least 150 days prior to filing a Preliminary Scoping Statement (16 NYCRR §1000.4). Attached is the preliminary PIP plan for the Project for review by the Siting Board pursuant to Section 1000.4 of the Article 10 regulations.

The attached PIP plan has been drafted to encourage public participation in the planning, pre-application, certification, compliance, and implementation process and to ensure that the Siting Board is made aware of stakeholder concerns about the Project throughout the Project application review process.

We look forward to working with the Siting Board, its staff and many others throughout the public involvement and review processes for the Project.
