NOTICE WITH RESPECT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

(Issued November 9, 2016)

On September 23, 2016, Borrego Solar Systems, Inc. filed a letter on behalf of multiple stakeholders engaged in the Interconnection Policy Working Group (IPWG), requesting that the Public Service Commission (Commission) reassess the milestones established in the Commission's "Order Granting Rehearing in Part, Establishing Transition Plan, and Making Other Findings" (Order), issued in Cases 14-E-0151 and 14-E-0422 on April 17, 2015. The letter seeks modification of the Order, by proposing an additional milestone for retaining monetary crediting for certain net metered projects.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Commission is seeking comments from interested entities regarding the IPWG stakeholder proposal. Pursuant to the State Administrative Procedure Act (SAPA) a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (Notice) was published in the State Register on October 12, 2016 (14-E-0151SP2), with respect to the IPWG stakeholder proposal. Comments with respect to the Notice are due on November 28, 2016.
