Van Ort will hold a procedural conference in the above-entitled cases on Thursday, September 8, 2016, beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the Public Service Commission's Albany offices, Three Empire State Plaza, 19<sup>th</sup> Floor Boardroom. On August 17, 2016, counsel for Brooklyn Union of L.I and National Grid NY advised that a joint proposal (JP) in resolution of these cases will be filed on or before August 31, 2016.

The purpose of the conference is to resolve any issues related to the schedule for these cases and discuss planning for an evidentiary hearing on the joint proposal. Judge Van Ort circulated the following proposed schedule to the parties for comment on August 19, 2016.
