Dear Ms. Burgess:

The Bull Run Wind Energy Center (the Project) is a proposed 300 MW wind energy project, located in Clinton County, New York in the Towns of Clinton, Ellenburg, Mooers, and Altona, owned and developed by Bull Run Energy LLC (BRE), an affiliate of Invenergy LLC. BRE has submitted an interconnection request, and NYISO and NYPA are performing an interconnection feasibility study for the Project.

Under Article 10 of the Public Service Law, the New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment (the Siting Board) requires an applicant proposing to construct a major electric generating facility to submit a Public Involvement Program (PIP) plan for review by the Department of Public Service (DPS) at least 150 days prior to filing a Preliminary Scoping Statement. Accordingly, with this letter please find the Project's preliminary PIP plan for review by the DPS.
