NOTICE CREATING A NEW MATTER NUMBER FOR  
CLEAN ENERGY PROGRAM EVALUATION, MEASUREMENT AND VERIFICATION

(Issued November 3, 2016)

In its January 21, 2016 Order<sup>1</sup> the Public Service Commission (Commission) directed Staff, in consultation with the Clean Energy Advisory Council (CEAC), to conduct a review of the "New York Evaluation Plan Guidance for Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard (EEPS) Program Administrators" and issue revised Evaluation Guidelines that balance the need for objective analysis with producing more expedient and actionable information to inform program and policy decisions.

In accordance with the Commission's directive, Staff issued Evaluation, Measurement & Verification Guidance (CE-05) on November 1, 2016, which states that the use of a designated matter for Evaluation, Measurement & Verification (EM&V) related filings will serve to further support transparency of EM&V activities, accountability for quality EM&V work, and the orderly tracking of clean energy program EM&V activities.
