Subject: 16-G-0058 - KEDLI and 16-G-0059 - KEDNY - Gas Rates

To the Parties:

This email is to confirm that the litigation schedule for the above-referenced cases is postponed, per the parties' request, for one month to allow for the continuing settlement negotiations. As you may recall from our June 15, 2016 conference call, I indicated that an extension of the schedule would be granted if KEDLI & KEDNY agreed to a corresponding one-month extension of the suspension period. The companies agreed to the suspension period extension, based on an understanding that Staff would support a "make whole" provision for any lost revenues that might result if the new rates do not go into effect on January 17, 2017. The letter from the companies memorializing the agreement to extend the suspension period was filed with the Commission's Secretary on June 17, 2016.

Parties have expressed a preference to commence the evidentiary hearing on August 1st; and, at least two parties are recommending that the hearing be held in NYC. We are in the process of setting up the public statement hearings (PSH) for these cases and will be coordinating those dates with the schedule for the evidentiary hearing. I, therefore, cannot set the specific dates for the evidentiary hearing at this time. The parties will be contacted if any additional input is needed regarding the hearing schedule.
