

### **Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (RG&E)**

RG&E has filed tariff revisions with the New York State Public Service Commission (PSC) in compliance with the PSC's order regarding a Reliability Support Service Surcharge (RSSS) to become effective March 1, 2016. The changes are to RG&E tariff schedules P.S.C. No. 18 – Electric Service for Street Lighting and P.S.C. No. 19 – Electric Service.

The RSSS is a surcharge designed to recover a portion of the costs associated with a Reliability Support Services Agreement between RG&E and the R.E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant, LLC. A Reliability Support Services Agreement provides for third-party services to ensure that local reliability needs are met.

The RSSS is designed to collect, on an annual basis, \$27.0 million as set forth in the "Order Adopting the Terms of a Joint Proposal", issued and effective February 24, 2016 in Case 14-E-0270. The collection amount shall be allocated to each service classification based upon the Company's 2008 transmission plant allocator. Amounts collected through the RSSS are reconciled on an annual basis.

### **Residential Customers**

A residential electricity customer with an average use of 600 kilowatt-hours/month can expect an average monthly bill increase of 0.3% over the temporary surcharge currently in place.
