NOTICE OF EVIDENTIARY HEARING

TAKE NOTICE that an evidentiary hearing will be held in the above-referenced case before Administrative Law Judges David R. Van Ort and James Costello, commencing Wednesday, October 26, 2016, beginning at 10:30 a.m. in the Public Service Commission's New York City offices, 90 Church Street, New York, New York, 4th Floor, Boardroom, and continuing daily as needed. The purpose of the hearing is to receive into evidence the Joint Proposal entered into by KEDLI and KEDNY (Companies), Staff of the Department of Public Service (Staff), and other active parties and admit into the record the pre-filed testimony and exhibits of the parties. The Joint Proposal was filed with the Commission's Secretary on September 7, 2016.

The Companies and Staff will each sponsor witness panels in support of the Joint Proposal that will be available for cross-examination at the hearing. Other parties may also sponsor witnesses in support of or opposition to the Joint Proposal, who will be subject to cross-examination.

All persons who intend to attend the hearing, and who are not Department of Public Service employees, must provide their name to the ALJs' secretary, Ms. Kelly Achzet, via e-mail (Kelly.Achzet@dps.ny.gov) or by telephone at (518) 474-4521 prior to 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 25, 2016, and must be prepared to show valid photo identification upon arrival at 90 Church Street.
