John,

Attached is a list of species we have found in recent surveys in the waterbodies listed. I was unable to find any fisheries information for Seeley Creek. I would expect to find minnow and sucker species similar to the other waterbodies in the list. I am not familiar with that creek and flow etc. but based on its proximity to Carrington Creek, it is possible that as long as there is some decent water in the creek there may be trout, either brook or brown. For any waters that are classified C(t) or C(ts) and no trout are listed in the recent survey data provided, it does not mean that trout are not present, they just were not found in the most recent survey at the sites that were surveyed. If they are classified as trout waters I would treat them as if they contain trout.

Also, I have not included any information pertaining to freshwater mussels which are likely present in some of these creeks. You may contact Amy Mahar (whom I cc'd) to see if there is any freshwater mussel information available. It may take a little while for her to get back in touch as her group is in the middle of field sampling and she is not in the office very much these days.
