Dear Mr. Colbert:

I received your letter dated November 4, 2016 on behalf of Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation (Central Hudson) requesting a further extension to file a copy of the actual journal entries recorded to account for the transfer of certain streetlights from Central Hudson to the Towns of Beacon and Poughkeepsie, as directed by the Commission's *Orders Approving Sale of Certain Street Lights to the City of Beacon and Poughkeepsie*, issued July 14 and July 15, 2016 respectively, in the above cases. The journal entries are due November 14, 2016.

You state that an extension is necessary because the street light facilities transactions have not closed, therefore, Central Hudson will not have the actual journal entries by the November 14, 2016 deadline. Further, you state that Central Hudson and the cities are in communication to close the transactions and anticipate that the transactions will close prior to December 30, 2016.

Based upon the information you have provided, this is to advise that an extension is granted to December 30, 2016 to Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation to file actual journal entries pertaining to the transfer of certain streetlights to the Towns of Beacon and Poughkeepsie. This extension is granted in order to promote the fair, orderly and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
