NOTICE OF PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a procedural conference will be held before Administrative Law Judges Ben Wiles and Sean Mullany on Monday, August 15, 2016, commencing at 1:00 p.m., in the Public Service Commission's Albany Offices, Empire State Plaza, Agency Building Three, Third Floor Hearing Room.

The principal purpose of the conference is to identify parties and major issues, to establish a schedule for the proceeding and to address issues related to the service of documents, discovery and any other procedural matters identified by the parties at the conference. Parties are urged to confer in advance on a proposed schedule in an effort to achieve a consensus. The Administrative Law Judges request that, to allow for timely Commission action, any proposed schedule provide for the filing of all post-hearing briefs by no later than Thursday, January 12, 2017. Please note that this initial notice has been served on you because you were on the service list for a prior Commission proceeding (*i.e.*, Case 11-G-0280).
