RE: Cases 16-E-0060 & 16-G-0061 - Con Edison Electric and Gas Rates

Dear Judges:

On September 19, 2016, Consumer Power Advocates (CPA) along with Consolidated Edison (the Company), Department of Public Service Staff (Staff or DPS), the City of New York (the City) and other interested parties filed a Joint Proposal (JP) to establish rates and other terms of service for electric and gas service covering the three- year period ending December 31, 2019. October 13, the New York Department of State Utility Intervention Unit (UIU) filed testimony and exhibits opposing the JP. These filings were accepted into the record at the evidentiary hearing on November 2. Please accept this letter as our post-hearing brief on the UIU filing.

CPA finds the objections to the JP raised by UIU to be unfounded and without merit. Moreover, no new issues were raised in the October 13 filing, and all these issues were successfully rebutted in previous filings by CPA and other parties. Without restating those arguments, we continue to oppose the revisions recommended by UIU, and support the JP in its entirety.
