NOTICE WITH RESPECT TO PETITION FOR MODIFICATIONS

(Issued November 9, 2016)

On September 30, 2016, the New York Solar Energy Industries Association filed a letter on behalf of multiple stakeholders engaged in the Interconnection Policy Working Group (IPWG), requesting that the Public Service Commission (Commission) modify the Standardized Interconnection Requirements and adopt proposed queue management and cost sharing proposals.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Commission is seeking comments from interested entities regarding the IPWG stakeholder queue management and cost sharing proposals. Pursuant to the State Administrative Procedure Act (SAPA) a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (Notice) was published in the State Register on October 19, 2016 (16-E-0560SP1), with respect to the IPWG stakeholder proposal. Comments with respect to the Notice are due on December 5, 2016.
