Enclosed are Time Warner Cable Inc.'s ("Time Warner Cable") and Charter Communications, Inc.'s ("Charter") Response to DPS-59 which were issued by the Department of Public Service Staff on October 15, 2015 ("Request").

Time Warner Cable and Charter note that certain of the Requests pertain to nonjurisdictional products, services and subjects. Moreover, certain of the Requests seek information about subject matter that falls outside of the scope of review permitted under federal and state law for the types of transactions at issue in the above-captioned proceeding. Charter and Time Warner Cable respectfully object to all such interrogatories and document requests. However, they are not withholding any information at this time based on such objection. In addition, Charter and Time Warner Cable respectfully reserve all rights under federal and state law and nothing in the Responses should be construed as a waiver of any right or objections that may otherwise be available to the parties.

In addition, pursuant to 16 N.Y.C.R.R. § 6-1.3(b)(1), Charter and Time Warner Cable Inc. are seeking exemption from public disclosure of the sections of their responses to DPS-59 and Exhibits 59-A and 59-B. The confidential versions of these documents have been shared with ALJ Wiles this afternoon.
