I received your letter dated October 25, 2016 on behalf of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (“National Grid” or the “Company”) requesting an extension to December 1, 2016 to file its annual Economic Development Program Plan (“Annual Program Plan”). The requirement for this filing was set forth in Section 11.4.2 of the Joint Proposal that was approved by the Commission in *Order Approving Electric and Gas Rate Plans in Accord with Joint Proposal*, issued March 15, 2013 in the above referenced proceedings. The Annual Program Plan is due October 31, 2016.


You state that the Company has been working on the plan, but due to resource issues the Company believes an additional extension of time is required to ensure that the plan accurately reflects the appropriate data and is most beneficial to the Company’s customers. Further, you state that the Company has advised the Department of Public Service Staff of its intention to file this request.

Based upon the information that you have provided, this is to advise that an extension has been granted to December 1, 2016 to National Grid to submit its Economic Development Program Plan. This extension is granted in order to promote the fair, orderly and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
