

I am writing you regarding the June 23, 2016 deadline to submit comments in case 14-M-0196 involving the request for the use of re-manufactured analog meters as specified in the Peoples Resolution.

It has come to my attention that the Utilities, specifically Central Hudson, has submitted a detailed comment against the use of re-manufactured analog meters and the precepts of the Peoples Resolution. 
