Regarding Syracuse Office Complex (SOC) renovations, please provide the following information:

- A. The actual amount of SOC renovations for each of the years 2005 2009.
- B The forecasted amount of SOC renovations for each of the years 2010 2012.
- C. Provide the amount of crane rental costs incurred in 2008 and 2009 on the SOC, the rental contract terms, the rental period(s), and the actual days the crane was operated during 2008 and 2009. Also, fully explain (1) how the crane rental schedule was developed, (2) why the crane sat idle for so many days during 2008 2009 and (3) why the overall crane rental costs were reasonable in light of the idle days. Provide the same information for year to date 2010.
- D. 1. Please provide all relevant documentation supporting the decision to go to "standard cube size" for Company employees; be sure to include all relevant documentation from National Grid UK.
- 2. Provide a quantification of the expected cost benefits of this decision.
- 3. Explain how these costs benefits are reflected in the rate year forecast.
- 4. What is the unitized cost of the new standard cubes being installed, broken down by component (desk, chair, etc)? Include a copy of an actual invoice for each such component. Also provide the actual / estimated average unitized labor and overhead costs to install each new standard cube.
- 5. How many standard cubes have been installed through 2009 and what is the total cost (components and all installation costs)?
- 6. What is the total estimated cost of the new standard cubes to be installed in 2010? 2011? 2012? How many standard cubes do these total costs cover?

- 7. How is the Company accounting for these costs (expense or capital) and what is the regulatory accounting rationale for such accounting?
- 8. What process was followed for determining which vendor would supply the new standard cubes? Was a RFP issued? Was it competitively bid? How was it decided which vendor would get the job to supply the new standard cubes?
- E. Please provide the number of office / department relocations that have occurred at the Syracuse SOC in each of the years 2005 -2009, along with planned office relocations for each of the years 2010 2012. Include the names of the offices / departments that were / will be relocated.
- F. Indicate how many of the offices / departments identified in E, above, were or are planned to be relocated more than once over the 2005 2012 timeframe. Include the names of the offices / departments that were / will be relocated more than once.
- G. What is the average cost of relocating an office / department?
- H. What is the undepreciated cost of the office furniture being replaced by all the new standard cubes? How is this cost reflected in the rate year forecast?
- What are the plans for disposing of all the office furniture being replaced? Will the furniture be re-sold? How was this reflected in the rate year forecast?
- J. What service company departments / offices have been relocated to the Syracuse SOC in each of the years 2005 2009? Which service company departments / offices are planned to be relocated to the Syracuse SOC in each of the years 2010 2012? What were the costs of these relocations? How did the Company account for these relocations? Were they considered to be costs to achieve KeySpan synergy savings? If not, explain why not.

Response:

- A. The actual amount of SOC renovations for each of the years 2005 2009 are show in Attachment 1 (RAV-112_Attach 1_SOC Actual Spend) broken out between prior asset management, and those projects associated with the current renovations project.
- B. Please refer to Exhibit (RRP-10), Workpapers for Exhibit (RRP-6), Schedule 1, Workpaper 7.
- C. National Grid does not have the information requested. The façade renovation project was bid as a Lump Sum project which includes all labor, material and equipment to perform the work. In a lump sum project the Contractor carries the costs for the equipment and it is their responsibility to utilize the equipment to its maximum value.
- D1. An evaluation of the current Office Standards and the adoption of new common standards across the entire U.S. National Grid foot print were undertaken as part of a broader initiative to look at National Grid's overall property strategy. Like many other companies, National Grid was attempting to better utilize the space currently occupied by the Company. The look and feel of the space occupied by employees across National Grid

varied dramatically from site to site. The U.S. strategy project developed the standards based on the information provided in Attachment 2 (RAV-112_Attach 2_UNY Rates RAV112 ex 2).

- D2. The renovations are required to accommodate business consolidations related to the support of the Transaction Delivery Center (TDC) referenced in Mr. Andrew Sloey's testimony and Transformation initiatives which are part of the company's continuous improvement initiatives and are described in the testimony of the Infrastructure and Operations Panel. The renovations will allow an expansion from 1,530 occupants to 2,100 occupants when completed. The adoption of the standard cubicle sizes and overall National Grid standards avoided the need to potentially acquire further space outside the A, B, C, D or F buildings at the Syracuse Office complex and make more efficient use of the total space.
- D3. Adoption of the new National Grid cubicle sizes and overall office standards is reflected, for example, in Exhibit RRP-2, Schedule 8, Sheet 9 where the savings from non-renewal of the "E" building are noted. The adoption of the new standards in the design of the renovations to the SOC avoided the necessity to retain "E" building and any potential refitting expense had the building been reopened for occupancy.
- D4. Based on the most recent negotiated price, the cubicles unit price is \$1448 which includes 6 panels, 3 work surfaces, 1-2 drawer lateral, 1-2 drawer pedestal with seat, 3 cantilevers, 1 pencil drawer and 1 end post However, a particular unit cost will vary based on what components go into each cubicle. For example, two cubicles may share one wall panel. In addition, each chair costs \$591 and the vendor cost to install the cubicle is \$145 per work station. Please see the sample invoices provided in Attachment 3 (RAV-112 Attach 3 Invoices).
- D5. As of December 31, 2009, 299 standard cubicles have been installed. The material cost for each cubicle is \$1,800 plus \$145 for installation. The total installed cost was \$581,555.
- D6. Between Standard and 'z-carol' style workstations, the Company estimates it will install 1,330 cubicles at a cost of \$1,448 each (reflecting most recent negotiated pricing) plus \$145 for installation for a total cost estimated of \$2,118,690.
- D7. The new cubicles are capitalized per plant accounting guidelines since the per unit material cost is in excess of \$200.
- D8. A formal bidding process was undertaken to select the vendor. A summary of the process is provided as Attachment 4 (RAV-112_Attach 4_UNY Rates RAV112 ex 3).

F. The departments that have relocated more than once are listed below. Overall, the intention has been not to relocate a group multiple times. Certain groups may have been moved into temporary space to allow renovations of their area. In addition, there may also be groups that have re-aligned under different organizations since the time the renovations began and may have been subsequently relocated to keep employees within groups in the same areas.

Call Center C-3 Account Processing C-3 Inventory Management Fleet Credit and Collection Information Services
Substation Design (as they reorganized and enlarged)
Distribution Support (as they centralized into the SOC).
Legal (As they reorganized)
Finance
Transaction Delivery Center (TDC) as it has evolved to a single group.

- G. There are many variables to estimating the cost for relocation including furniture requirements. However, the Company utilizes an estimate of approximately \$400 to relocate an employee between existing cubicles which includes Facilities labor and IS labor to move the phone and PC.
- H. The un-depreciated cost of the office furniture being replaced is not identifiable as a result of the Company amortizing general equipment effective 1/1/1995 as filed in Rate Case 94-E-0098, 94-E-0099, Case 94-G-0100 and Cases 29327 et al. As a result of this change in accounting, the Company books additions to the general equipment accounts in the Continuing Property Records (CPR) at a vintage level only. The Company does not track general equipment at a location level nor record interim retirements. Instead the vintage year group continues to be amortized until it becomes fully amortized and then the original cost of that entire vintage is retired.
- I. To the extent possible, original furniture was adapted to new standards; otherwise, remaining furniture is being traded in to the vendor and credited against any new purchases in form of a reduced cost.
- J. National Grid has moved Credit & Collections, Accounts Payable, Employee Services, Compensation & Benefits and Procurement to the Syracuse Complex in the years 2005-2009. National Grid has not strictly tracked the cost of individual department moves; however, although the work has been moved to the SOC, it is generally being performed by personnel who were already located in the SOC and transferred to the newly created positions or by newly hired employees. Establishing additional service company departments at the SOC in the TDC area in the future is under consideration, however, no decisions have been made at this date.

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

NARRATIVE DETAILS OF JOB AWARD:

The Syracuse Office Complex (SOC) renovation was undertaken in order to accommodate additional employees moving into the SOC, as well as to achieve an office "standard" (environment) identical to that of Reservoir Woods in Massachusetts and Metrotech in Brooklyn. The entire SOC renovation was originally estimated to be \$5.8M; the furniture/office equipment (hereafter referred to as "furniture") projected cost breakdown:

The furniture price was anticipated to be reduced by remanufacturing existing product when possible, and by buying in volume for new product when there was no option for remanufacture. Based on the National Grid furniture standard with one manufacturer – Herman Miller – the available suppliers to bid were limited to Tobron Office Furniture Corp. (Tobron) and Roberts Office Furniture Concepts, Inc (Roberts). Tobron is a Herman Miller distributor and outfitted both National Grid facilities in Metrotech and Reservoir Woods with Herman Miller product. Robert's ability to remanufacture product was evaluated by Facilities Management leadership at the onset of their original contract in 2005, and determined to be the supplier of choice for remanufactured furniture.

Based on the quality and availability of product, combined with the desire to keep the project cost as low as possible, the following project guidelines for procuring furniture were adopted:

- 1. Secure new furniture/equipment from Tobron
- 2. Secure re-manufactured furniture/equipment from Roberts
- 3. Go to bid with the two above mentioned suppliers for Herman Miller furniture/equipment that could go either way (new or re-manufactured) and see what the cost differential and/or product delivery situation yields.

This bid was conducted in Ariba; the Procurement project team consisted of Colleen Keane and Jim Swalec, with the internal customers being Kevin Richardson and Pat Burns. The project sponsor was Steve Lucas, Executive Director of Finance and Shared Services.

^{*} Note: Tobron did offer a concession of \$72,820.32 at this negotiation point, bringing their final bid offer down to \$2,579,130.16. However, this submission was not accepted due to the technical specifications altered to offer this price reduction (Tobron proposed eliminating the required center drawer of the desk space.)

In addition to the line item unit pricing, product delivery and unloading costs, and extra work line items (comprised of labor rates for miscellaneous laborers as well as for project Managers), considerations critical to evaluating the bids were: The bidder's estimated product delivery date, the bidder's Safety record, the bidder's adherence to specifications/technical requirements.

Summary of Evaluation:

- Commercial terms: both bidders satisfactorily completed the commercial requirements including having acceptable Safety records and executing the required documents (Background Check form, Safety form, Terms and Conditions).
- Unit/Installation pricing: The unit price of the product did not vary greatly in price between the two bidders, but the installation cost for Tobron was 2 to 3 times the price that Roberts would install for. (Differential based on product)
- Labor rate: The labor rate for Tobron was twice that of Robert's labor rates.
- Delivery Date: Tobron could deliver the product in it's entirety to the SOC, by the desired April 1, 2010 date. Roberts could offer 1/3 of the project's product by the desired date, with the remainder of the product to be delivered as it was remanufactured; the entire project's product would be delivered in May 2010.
- Payment terms: Tobron requested a 60% down payment on product.
 Roberts initially offered payment terms of net 30 and at the final round of negotiation offered 1 %10 net 30.
- Old furniture buyback: Tobron offered no buyback policy. Roberts offered
 a credit for the existing SOC furniture to be replaced at 5 cents on a dollar
 plus any surplus furniture stored in the Syracuse 'E' Building that might be
 remanufactured. [Note: the current Roberts contract provides a buyback
 at 4 cents on a dollar.]
- Diversity consideration: Tobron is a woman owned business. Roberts is veteran and small business owned.

The dollar savings to award to Roberts is the \$109,155 difference between Robert's original bid submission minus their final bid submission post negotiation. Even if National Grid were not to consider Robert's buyback (credit) option, the dollar difference between Roberts and Tobron is almost \$400,000 – and this is not including the cost for labor for the project. (Reference attached evaluation.)

This contract is for the duration of the project requirements (estimated to be November 2010), for a total value rounded up to \$2,500,000. We have received DOA from the Line of Business for \$5,000,000 for furniture needs which covers the full value of this contract. The Sanction Paper submitted by Steve Lucas serves as the DOA for this project (reference attachment).

It is recommended to award the SOC Furniture/Office equipment Project to Roberts Office Furniture Concepts, Inc. based on this company being the lowest evaluated bidder. Roberts has submitted the following commercial documents:



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
