Re: Case 24-E-0498 – Tariff Filing by New York Municipal Power Agency to Modify Its Electric Tariff Schedule, P.S.C. No. 1, to Establish Rider B - Outdoor Lighting Service Class, and Rider C - Purchase of Renewable Energy from New Distributed Generators.

Dear Hunter Reinhardt and Konstantin Podolny:

I received your March 10, 2026 letter, filed on behalf of the New York Municipal Power Agency (NYMPA), requesting additional extensions of time to comply with directives set forth in the Commission's *Order Authorizing Tariff Amendments with Modifications* (Order), issued August 18, 2025, in this proceeding. Pursuant to previous extension rulings, filings are required by March 16, 17, and 27, 2026.

In your letter, you request a one-month extension of the March 16 due date for members to file the amended tariff leaves and workpapers as required by Ordering Clauses 5 and 6; a one-month extension of the March 17 due date for website publication as required by Ordering Clause 14; and a one-month extension of the March 27 due date to file a notice of completion as required by Ordering Clause 15. You state that, despite diligent efforts to comply, several NYMPA members need more time to finalize and verify information.

Based on the information provided, extensions until the dates indicated are granted to each member of the New York Municipal Power Agency as follows: April 16, 2026, to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clauses 5 and 6; April 17, 2026, to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clause 14; and April 27, 2026, to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clause 15 of the Order.
