Dear Felice Segura:

I received your July 1, 2025 letter requesting an extension of time to comply with the Commission's *Order Authorizing Low- to Moderate-Income Energy Efficiency and Building Electrification Portfolios for 2026-2030* (Order), issued May 15, 2025, in Case 25-M-0249. In relevant part, the Order requires the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) and the Joint Utilities to file a Customer Referral Plan, for Department of Public Service (DPS) staff review and approval, by July 14, 2025.

You state that NYSERDA and the Joint Utilities are working collaboratively to develop a plan that aligns with the Order's directives, but, due to complexities associated with the development process, additional time is needed to complete and file a plan for DPS staff's review.

Based on the foregoing, an extension until August 22, 2025, is granted to NYSERDA and the Joint Utilities to file the plan required by the Order. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of these proceedings, and this ruling will be posted on the Department's website.
