
Enclosed please find Lockheed Martin IMS' response, as the North American Numbering Plan Administrator ("NANPA"), to a Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") directive concerning a reconsideration of the 914 NPA rationing plan. Included in that response is a copy of the notes from a meeting of the 914 NPA code holders and other industry members held May 11, 1999 to address the issue.

In addition to addressing the reconsideration of the rationing plan, the industry participants at the May 11 meeting also discussed the current status of the 914 NPA, which is nearing exhaust. In view of this, the industry participants, through consensus, have requested NANPA to communicate the following statement to the New York Department of Public Service ("NYDPS") on their behalf:

"The industry urges the Commission to move expeditiously to order area code relief for the 914 NPA. The numbering situation in 914 is at a crisis point. All available NXX Codes have been allocated to carriers with the exception of an emergency pool of ten (10) NXX Codes. Without available NXX Codes, carriers will be unable to provide services to their customers."

Dear Mr. Varma:

In a letter dated April 7, 1999, the Common Carrier Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission ("Bureau"), directed Lockheed Martin IMS, as the North American Numbering Plan Administrator ("NANPA"), to assign additional numbering resources to American Cellular Corporation in advance of the assignment schedule provided for in the 914 Number Plan Area ("NPA") rationing plan.¹ The Bureau also instructed NANPA, in its capacity as the central office code administrator, to convene an industry meeting to reconsider the 914 NPA rationing plan and to consider the issue of how to address emergency requests for relief, like that of American Cellular Corporation, that may arise in the future. You requested that NANPA submit a response within 45 days of the date of the April 7, 1999 letter. Pursuant to that request and on behalf of the industry, NANPA hereby files its report.²

In compliance with the Bureau directive, NANPA convened a meeting on May 11, 1999 in New York City of code holders and other industry members to reconsider the 914 NPA rationing Plan. The meeting was attended by twenty-two individuals representing thirteen entities, including the New York Department of Public Service ("NYDPS"). A copy of the final industry approved notes from the meeting is attached for your information.

The meeting agenda included a review of a Bell Atlantic contribution that was offered to facilitate resolution of the issue. Following some minor modifications, the contribution was ultimately adopted by the industry, through consensus, as an acceptable procedure for addressing future emergency requests for numbering relief. A copy of the Industry Consensus for the Distribution of the Codes remaining in the NPA 914 is attached for your review.

In light of this industry agreement, NANPA considers this matter resolved and concludes that no further NANPA action is required. Please do not hesitate to contact me at (202) 756-5796 if you have any questions regarding this matter.

RECONSIDERATION OF THE 914 NPA RATIONING PLAN
INDUSTRY MEETING

TUESDAY, MAY 11, 1999

WELCOME & INTRODUCTIONS

Wayne Milby, Senior NPA Relief Planner – NANPA, welcomed everyone and asked the meeting participants to introduce themselves and identify the companies they represented. See Attachment 1 for the names of those who attended the meeting.

STATUS OF 914 NPA JEOPARDY CODE ASSIGNMENTS

Cecilia Louie of NANPA CO Code Administration provided a status of the 914 NPA (see Attachment 2). Cecilia advised that an additional 17 codes were returned to the pool which raises the number of available codes to 54. There are currently 54 NXX codes available for assignment, and an additional 30 NXX codes on the reserved list.

Bell Atlantic asked for additional time to check to make sure the 17 codes were actually returned before NANPA CO Code Administration includes them in the total available codes.

Action Item: Bell Atlantic will provide a status of the 17 codes at the conference call to approve the minutes of this meeting.

On the subsequent conference call held May 24, 1999 to approve these notes, Bell Atlantic provided the following response to the aforementioned Action Item:

- *The 560 NXX can be returned to the pool of available codes for assignment in the 516 NPA.*
- *The 800 and 900 NXXs can be returned to the pool of available codes for assignment in the 516 NPA. However, Bell Atlantic requests that these NXX codes be reserved for assignment as a last resort to avoid customer dialing confusion.*
- *The 717 and 920 NXXs will be reclassified in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) as Bell Atlantic codes in the 516 NPA, and will be excluded from assignment.*

Bell Atlantic also indicated that it is conducting an internal meeting on Wednesday, May 26, 1999 to evaluate the status of the remaining seventeen (17) NXX codes to determine which, if any, can be returned to the pool of available NXX codes. Following that meeting, Bell Atlantic will advise NANPA of its decision to return codes.

The participants reviewed the list of 914 Test and Reserve codes to determine if any of the codes can be returned to the pool for future assignment (see Attachment 2).

Action Item: All participants will research the remaining list of 914 Test and Reserve Codes to determine if any codes can be returned for assignment, and provide a report of their findings on the upcoming conference call to approve these notes.

On the subsequent conference call held May 24, 1999 to approve these notes, there were no additional concerns stated in response to the aforementioned Action Item.

CONSENSUS ON METHOD TO PROVIDE NXX CODES FOR EMERGENCY REQUESTS

Bell Atlantic provided a proposal to assign NXX codes for emergency requests in the 914 NPA. The participants reviewed the proposal, which was modeled after one that was adopted at a meeting one day earlier to address the rationing of the remaining NXX codes in the 516 NPA.

NANPA CO Code Administration noted that it appears that approximately 10 additional carriers will be added to the 914 Priority list.

Action Item: NANPA CO Code Administration will look at existing lotteries in all NPAs in the entire Bell Atlantic region to determine if there are other situations where the number of companies on the Priority List is reaching the number of available codes. Additionally, NANPA CO Code Administration will determine if it can adopt the policy to suspend the NXX lottery process, anywhere throughout the Bell Atlantic region, whenever the number of NXX requests exceeds the number of available codes.

In view of the current status of NXX codes available for assignment in the 914 NPA, consensus was reached to suspend the 914 NPA Lottery process, effective with the June lottery. The May Lottery will be processed as scheduled.

On the subsequent conference call held May 24, 1999 to approve these notes, NANPA CO Code Administration indicated that, in accordance with industry consensus, it would suspend the NXX lottery process for a particular NPA, anywhere throughout the Bell Atlantic region, in the event the number of NXX requests exceeds the number of available codes.

Statement for the Record (MCI Worldcom): MCI Worldcom notes its objection to those parts of the Bell Atlantic's revised "Contribution for the Distribution of the Codes Remaining in NPA 914" that limit the ability of carriers with more than one OCN per industry segment to request codes. The INC Guidelines allow for code requests by OCN.

Consensus was reached to change the number of codes reserved for an overlay in the 914 NPA from 30 codes to 20 codes. The ten NXX codes transferred from the overlay codes will be used as emergency codes.

A suggestion was made to revise the number of NXX codes allocated to the emergency 914 NXX pool from 12 to 10 codes.

Consensus was reached to revise the proposal to reflect an allocation of 10 NXX codes to the 914 Emergency pool.

Consensus was reached to adopt the Bell Atlantic Proposal for the Distribution of the Codes Remaining in NPA 914, as revised at this meeting.

Consensus was reached that NANPA CO Code Administration will provide the industry with a monthly report of the status of the 914 NPA pool.

CONSENSUS TO REPORT THE RESULTS TO THE FCC

Consensus was reached that NANPA will report the results of this meeting in a letter to the FCC.

A discussion ensued regarding the dire state of the 914 NPA in the absence of a relief decision from the New York State Department of Public Service.

Consensus was reached that NANPA will file the results of this meeting with the FCC.

Consensus was reached that in addition to reporting the results of this meeting to the FCC, NANPA will forward a transmittal to the New York State Department of Public Service containing the following text on behalf of the industry:

“The industry urges the Commission to move expeditiously to order area code relief for the 914 NPA. The numbering situation in 914 is at a crisis point. All available NXX codes have been allocated to carriers with the exception of an emergency pool of ten (10) NXX codes. Without available NXX codes, carriers will be unable to provide services to their customers.”

DATE FOR CONFERENCE CALL TO APPROVE MEETING MINUTES

Consensus was reached that NANPA will distribute the draft notes resulting from this meeting to the industry on May 20, 1999 via facsimile, coincident with the distribution of the May 10, 1999 516 NPA meeting notes. Additionally, consensus was reached to conduct a conference call on May 24, 1999 at 10:00 AM (EST) to review and approve these draft notes. This conference call will be held in conjunction with one that is already scheduled on the same date regarding the reconsideration the 516 NPA rationing plan. Return of Codes

1. Any codes assigned prior to 5/1/99 and not activated within six months of the assignment date must be returned to the pool. Any codes assigned after 5/1/99 must be activated within three months of the assignment date, unless technical difficulties exist beyond the carrier's control. In the event of difficulties, this carrier will notify NANPA in writing on or before 90 days documenting an anticipated activation date.
2. The current code allocations will be reviewed to determine codes assigned to carriers under multiple OCNs. Any carrier currently holding multiple priority numbers issued in any one month as a result of requests under multiple OCN's will relinquish all but one of the code allocations.
3. Effective June 1, 1999, Lockheed Martin will begin reclamation procedures on any codes assigned on or before 12/1/98 and not yet activated. NANPA will continue reclamation based on a three-month activation period until relief is implemented.
4. Any codes returned will revert to the pool from which they were assigned.

Emergency Pool

An emergency pool of 10 codes will be established and assigned on a first come, first served basis. A carrier meeting the imminent exhaust assignment criteria identified below will be allotted a code from this pool. Carriers may request codes under only one OCN per industry segment. Requests can be submitted to NANPA CO Code Administration beginning June 1, 1999 at 8:00 AM (PDT)/11:00 AM (EDT).

Imminent Exhaust Assignment Criteria

A. Growth Codes

1. A carrier must supply to NANPA a Months-to-Exhaust form demonstrating, by switch or by rate center, number exhaust within three months.
2. The carrier must also supply to NANPA six months of historic utilization data and six months forecast data to support the exhaust projections. If the average projected monthly demand is within 15% of the average historical monthly utilization, a code will be assigned. If the demand exceeds 15%

- of the utilization, the carrier must explain the deviation prior to code assignment.
3. The carrier must review all numbers in their reserved status to insure that it only retains those numbers for which the carrier has a legally enforceable written agreement.
 4. The carrier must have reduced its aging period to 30 days unless a longer period is required by state regulation or a contractual agreement.

B. Initial Code in a Rate Center

1. A carrier must supply to NANPA documentation, by switch or by rate center, of a bona fide request to provide service within three months.
2. The carrier must also supply to NANPA documentation that within three months, it will be interconnected and have sufficient operable facilities in the switch/rate center requested.

Assignment of Remaining Codes

The codes remaining to be assigned after the establishment of the emergency pool, will be assigned, until exhausted, in priority number order, to those carriers already on the priority list and meeting the extreme exhaust criteria listed below. NANPA will immediately notify carriers holding priority numbers that in order to retain their priority number, by June 1, 1999, they must provide the documentation required in the extreme exhaust assignment criteria. Assignments will be complete and notification sent to the carriers by June 15, 1999.

Extreme Exhaust Assignment Criteria

A. Growth Codes

1. A carrier must supply to NANPA a Months-to-Exhaust form demonstrating, by switch or by rate center, number exhaust within four months.
2. The carrier must also supply to NANPA six months of historic utilization data and six months forecast data to support the exhaust projections. If the average projected monthly demand is within 15% of the average historical monthly utilization, a code will be assigned. If the demand exceeds 15% of the utilization, the carrier must explain the deviation prior to code assignment.
3. The carrier must review all numbers in its reserved status to insure that it retains only numbers for which the carrier has a legally enforceable written agreement.

4. The carrier must have reduced its aging period to 30 days unless a longer period is required by state regulation or a contractual agreement.

B. Initial Code in a Rate Center

1. A carrier must supply to NANPA documentation, by switch or by rate center, of a bona fide request to provide service within four months.
2. The carrier must also supply to NANPA documentation that within four months, it will be interconnected and have sufficient operable facilities in the switch/rate center requested.

**Suspension/Denial of a Code Application
(Imminent or Extreme Exhaust, Growth or Initial)**

1. If NANPA determines that the documentation submitted by an applicant does not meet the established criteria, NANPA should suspend the application and allow the applicant two weeks to resubmit its documentation.
2. If the documentation is not resubmitted or NANPA determines that the documentation still does not meet the established criteria, the code request will be denied.
