NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS

(Issued June 17, 2026)

In its Order Modifying Managed Charging Programs, issued August 18, 2025, the Public Service Commission (Commission) directed the Joint Utilities to file a Comprehensive Managed Charging Report (Report) and host a technical conference to initiate a review of the Commission-approved residential electric vehicle managed charging programs.¹ The Joint Utilities were directed to include insights in both the Report and technical conference that would inform a thorough program review, including "an overview and results of the programs, grid impacts, lessons learned, insights to customer charging behaviors including customer enrollment and engagement by utility, and any recommendations to program designs and implementation that could optimize any of the programs, if continued in the future."² The Joint Utilities filed the Report

on March 16, 2026, and hosted the technical conference on March 31, 2026.³

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that comments are requested on (1) the Report and (2) on the March 31, 2026 technical conference as part of the Department of Public Service (Department) staff's ongoing residential electric vehicle managed charging program review. All comments should refer to "Case 18-E-0138." Initial comments should be submitted by **July 17, 2026**, and reply comments should be submitted by **August 3, 2026**.

Comments should be e-filed using the Department's Document and Matter Management system (DMM).⁴ Those unable to file electronically may mail their comments to the Hon. Michelle L.
