CASE 22-E-0064 - Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. for Electric Service.

NOTICE ESTABLISHING REPLY COMMENT DEADLINE

(Issued November 28, 2023)

On August 22, 2023, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Edison) filed a petition requesting that the Public Service Commission (Commission) issue an order authorizing it to proceed with its proposed Idlewild Project to address its forecast that the Jamaica Network would experience exceedances beginning in 2026. To address this reliability issue, Con Edison seeks authority to construct its Idlewild Project and recover the associated costs from customers.

Pursuant to the State Administrative Procedure Act (SAPA) Section 202(1), a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking was published in the State Register on September 20, 2023 [SAPA No. 22-E-0064SP2] (September 2023 SAPA Notice), for a comment period that ended on November 20, 2023. Comments in response to September 2023 SAPA Notice were received from the City of New York, Metropolitan Transportation Authority, New York Battery and Energy Storage Technology Consortium, Inc., and Ninedot Energy. The comments received raise several concerns and issues regarding the proposed Idlewild Project. To improve the record before the Commission, a reply comment deadline is hereby established for the limited purpose of addressing the comments filed in response to the September 2023 SAPA notice.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that reply comments from interested entities addressing issues raised in the comments that were

filed in response to the September 2023 SAPA Notice in this proceeding are requested by **December 12, 2023**. The reply comments should reference "Case 22-E-0064" and should be submitted as follows:
