

Community Choice Aggregation 2024 Annual Report Supplement

Joule Assets, Inc.

In addition to the DPS reporting template, which contains most of the CCA Annual Report information, Joule Assets, Inc. (Joule) submits this supplement to address two items not included in the template, value added services and plans for soliciting a new contract.

Value Added Services

In 2024 Joule has provided value added services related to the development of distributed energy resources in many of our communities, evaluating more than 500 prospective sites.

Plans for Soliciting a New Contract

Joule currently serves as CCA administrator for fifteen municipalities whose electricity supply contracts are set to expire in 2025. Of these municipalities, twelve are part of Joule's Hudson Valley Community Power Aggregation (list below), one (the Town of Henrietta) is part of Joule's Monroe Community Power Aggregation, one (City of Canandaigua) is part of Joule's Gateway Community Power Aggregation and one (City of Rochester) is branded by municipality, Rochester Community Power.

Joule will solicit various options for default supply including bids for 100% New York Renewable electricity, 50% New York Renewable electricity and standard. As always, consideration will be given to price and term length to secure optimal rates for participating municipalities.
