and Maintain Transformer Vaults.

NOTICE EXTENDING COMMENT DEADLINE

(Issued January 31, 2024)

On January 10, 2024, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation
d/b/a National Grid (National Grid or the Company) filed its
Petition for a Declaratory Ruling Regarding Customer
Responsibility to Provide and Maintain Transformer Vaults (the
Petition) in the above-captioned proceeding. In the Petition,
the Company requested that the Public Service Commission (the
Commission) issue a declaratory ruling affirming its
interpretation of certain provisions of its P.S.C. No. 220 -
Electric Service Tariff (Tariff) regarding a customer's
responsibility to provide and maintain vaults or enclosures
required for Company-owned transformers and equipment used to
provide electric service to the customer. Pursuant to Title 16
of the New York State Codes Rules and Regulations (NYCRR)
§8.2(c), responses to the Petition ordinarily would be due by
January 31, 2024.

On January 30, 2024, multiple entities filed requests
for extensions of time to respond to the Petition. The requests
generally state that the requester would either be directly
affected by or interested in the requested ruling, but was not
served the Petition by the Company, pursuant to 16 NYCRR
§8.2(b), and thus were not afforded the full 21-day response
period.
