I received your letter dated May 12, 2026, submitted on behalf of Department of Public Service staff, requesting an extension of time to comply with the directives set forth in the Commission's *Order Adopting Clean Energy Standard Biennial Review as Final and Making Other Findings* (Order), issued May 15, 2025, in the above-referenced proceeding. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 11, staff must file a white paper that evaluates the existing solicitation process utilized in the Clean Energy Standard and provides recommendations for improvements by May 15, 2026.

You state that staff's evaluation, including the review of stakeholder comments received, is ongoing. Accordingly, you request additional time to comply with Ordering Clause 11.
