

**Case 19-M-0463 – In the Matter of Consolidated Billing for Distributed Energy Resources**

**Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid  
Annual Net Crediting Report for Calendar Year 2023**

In accordance with Ordering Clause 10 of the New York Public Service Commission’s Order Regarding Consolidated Billing for Community Distributed Generation in this proceeding,<sup>1</sup> Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (“National Grid” or “the Company”) files its Annual Community Distributed Generation Net Crediting Report for Calendar Year 2023 (“Annual CDG Net Crediting Report”).

As set forth in the Net Crediting Order, the Annual CDG Net Crediting Report must include information on:

1. Costs associated with the implementation and operation of the CDG net crediting program.
2. The amounts recovered from CDG sponsors participating in net crediting.
3. The number of CDG sponsors participating in net crediting.
4. Number of CDG projects participating in net crediting.
5. Capacity of CDG projects participating in net crediting.
6. Number of customers participating in the CDG net crediting program.<sup>2</sup>

Table 1, below, summarizes the Company’s calendar year 2023 CDG net crediting information.
