Attached please find the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) On-Bill Recovery Quarterly Report for the quarter ending December 31, 2016. The Green Jobs-Green New York (GJGNY) Act, enacted in October 2009, requires NYSERDA to provide innovative financing mechanisms and a revolving loan fund to support energy efficiency retrofits in residential buildings (1-to-4 unit), small businesses (100 employees or less), not-for-profit facilities, and multifamily buildings (5 units or more). The Power NY Act of 2011, enacted August 4, 2011, authorized NYSERDA to offer loans through the GJGNY program repayable through an installment charge on the customer's electric or gas corporation utility bill.

Pursuant to the April 24, 2012 Public Service Commission *Order Establishing Reporting Requirements Regarding the On-Bill Recovery Program* in Case 12-M-0007, NYSERDA and the applicable utilities are directed to file quarterly reports in the format provided in the Order Appendix.
