NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS

(Issued September 12, 2025)

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that comments are requested concerning the Department of Public Service staff proposal that was filed on September 11, 2025, in this proceeding (the Proposal). The Proposal recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) grant an extension until December 31, 2030, related to the current exemption from Buyback Service Contract Demand Charges for qualifying stand-alone energy storage facilities, as approved in the Commission's Order Establishing an Allocated Cost of Service Methodology for Standby and Buyback Service Rates and Energy Storage Contract Demand Charge Exemptions, issued on March 16, 2022.
