In accordance with the New York State Public Service Commission's Order Authorizing Non-Low- to Moderate-Income (Non-LMI) Energy Efficiency and Building Electrification (EE/BE) Portfolios for 2026-2030<sup>1</sup> and the New York State Department of Public Service's Director's Letter,<sup>2</sup> Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. submits the attached Updated Non-Low to Moderate Income Energy Efficiency and Building Electrification Implementation Plan (IP) and Companion Template.

This revised IP is complementary to the Downstate Regional Weatherization Proposal filed in the above-captioned proceeding on March 6, 2026.

The revised IP includes funding shifts from the BE sub-portfolio to the Weatherization and Other EE sub-portfolios. The Company adjusted spending and achievement for the Non-LMI subsectors – Building Electrification, Weatherization and Other EE – throughout this update to the Non-LMI IP.
