VDER Value Stack Capacity Alternative 2 Value

Dear Secretary Phillips:

New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (“NYSEG”) and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E”), (together the “Companies”), are submitting its capacity values for Alternative 2 of the Value Stack tariff in accordance with the New York State Public Service Commission’s (the “Commission”) Order on Net Energy Metering Transition, Phase One of the Value of Distributed Energy Resources, and Related Matters, issued and effective March 9, 2017 (“Order”), and the Order Regarding Value Stack Compensation¹, issued and effective April 18, 2019 in the above-referenced proceedings. The utilities are required to submit its Alternative 2 capacity value under the Phase One Value Stack tariff by May 15 of each year.

These rates will be effective for the upcoming 2026 summer capacity period.

¹ The April 2019 Order adopted the calculations for the Alternative 2 capacity values.
