I received your letter dated October 16, 2024, filed on behalf of the Joint Utilities, requesting an extension of time to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clause 20 of the Commission's *Order Establishing Updated Energy Storage Goal and Deployment Policy*, issued June 20, 2024, in the above-referenced proceeding. In accordance with Ordering Clause 20, the Joint Utilities were directed to study the non-market transmission and distribution services that energy storage can provide and file the results of that study October 18, 2024.

You state that the Joint Utilities are requesting a brief extension of the filing deadline to continue to work actively and collaboratively to fully respond to the Commission's directives.
