- 3) Utility System Updates Josh Pasquariello
  - a. Central Hudson
    - i issues that were resolved
  - SAC10 Segment issues. CenHud system was sending a blank in this field, it has been resolved.
  - Issue with 810 not being sent, Issue has been resolved, data flow resumed. For 810s that were not sent, CenHud will be sending them "eventually." Once the unsent files are retriggered, CenHud will contact affected stakeholders letting them know of the resolution.
  - All files being re-transmitted will be sent out under original ISA batch numbers.
  - All outbound 867s have been sent.
    - ii open issues
  - MEA Segment, issue is ongoing.
  - Negative 997 issue, issue ongoing.
  - N1 SJ segment, affected 700+ customers. Issue is ongoing, CenHud requests affected stakeholders.
  - TDS Segment, issue is ongoing, the negative symbol is populating after rather than before the amount.
  - POR Issue, issue is ongoing, CenHud is actively working to resolve. This ties to the 820 issue; the 820 is CenHuds POR process, the files were supposed to be sent out the night of 9/22. There was an issue with the batch release. CenHud releasing the batch again to resolve the issue.
  - Timeline for when new portal will be up and running? Meter read cycle, load profiles are data missing from portal at this time. Load profiles will be added in within next two weeks after 9/23 working group call. Once account gets billed, accounts should display on the portal.

**Con Edison** System Changes: Sue Tworti, May 2023 Con Ed/O&R replacing customer information system. It will be a new customer billing information system. ConEd/O&R will be having continuing technical conferences to discuss the impacts of this change.
