ANNUAL REPORT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that comments are sought on the Indian Point Closure Task Force 2024 Annual Update (Report) that was filed on April 26, 2024, in the above-captioned matter. The Report provides updates on plant operations, decommissioning plans, and progress being made to address the range of issues related to the closure of Indian Point, including property tax impacts and resources, labor impacts and resources, public safety impacts, and decommissioning impacts. The Report also discusses the additional State Programs that are available, as well as State and Local Legislative and community efforts.

Interested persons and entities are invited to submit comments on the Report by May 28, 2024.
