MATTER 14-01299 - In the Matter of PSEG-LI Utility 2.0 Long Range Plan.

NOTICE REQUESTING COMMENTS

(Issued July 6, 2023)

The New York State Department of Public Service (DPS or Department) is seeking comment on PSEG Long Island's (PSEG LI) proposed Utility 2.0 Long Range Plan 2023 Annual Update (Utility 2.0 Plan). On June 30, 2023, in accordance with the Long Island Power Authority Reform Act (LRA), PSEG LI submitted the Utility 2.0 Plan to the DPS for review and recommendation. Pursuant to the LRA, the purpose of the Utility 2.0 Plan is to implement energy efficiency measures, distributed generation, or advanced grid technology programs providing customers with tools to more efficiently and effectively manage their energy usage and utility bills, and improve system reliability and power quality.

The Department's review of the Utility 2.0 Plan is being conducted concurrently with its review of PSEG LI's 2023 Energy Efficiency (EE) Plan, submitted as an Appendix to the Utility 2.0 Plan. Interested persons or parties are invited to submit comments regarding the Utility 2.0 Plan and the EE Plan by **Monday, August 21, 2023**. Reply comments are requested by **Wednesday, September 6, 2023**.
