CASE 25-T-0311 - Joint Petition of Minard Run Oil Company and Greenway Energy, LLC for Approval Pursuant to Section 121 of the New York Public Service Law, of the Transfer of Certificates of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need.

NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS

(Issued July 18, 2025)

On November 29, 2012, the Public Service Commission (Commission) approved the transfer of 19 Certificates of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) for various two-inch, four-inch, and one eight-inch pipeline(s) in Cayuga, Seneca, and Wayne Counties, New York from Chesapeake Appalachia, LLC (Chesapeake) to Minard Run Oil Company (Minard Run). On October 14, 2016, the Commission also approved the transfer of a Certificate for a 12,370-foot-long, six-inch steel pipeline in the Town of Eaton, Madison County, New York, from Emkey Resources, LLC to Minard Run.

In a joint petition filed on May 30, 2025 (Transfer Petition), pursuant to Public Service Law §121(2), Minard Run requests Commission authorization to transfer the 20 Certificates to Greenway Energy, LLC (Greenway), a subsidiary of PPP Future Development, Inc. Minard Run and Greenway state in the Transfer Petition that Greenway will operate the pipelines in the same manner as Minard Run and that Greenway will adhere to the terms, limitations, and conditions of the Certificates and Commission gas safety regulations.
