Re: Case 19-M-0463 – In the Matter of Consolidated Billing for Distributed Energy Resources.

Dear Secretary Phillips,

The New York State Public Service Commission’s *Order Regarding Consolidated Billing for Community Distributed Generation* in Case 19-M-0463 (“Net Crediting Order”), issued and effective December 12, 2019, established the policies, requirements, and conditions to implement Net Crediting.

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 10, the Commission directed each utility to track costs associated with the implementation and operation of the net crediting model, as well as the amount covered through the discount rate. The Commission also directed the utilities to file an annual report on March 31 of each year for the preceding year, beginning March 31, 2021. Additionally, the Commission ordered each utility to report on the number of CDG Sponsors participating in net crediting, as well as the number and capacity of projects and the number of participating customers.

New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (“NYSEG”) and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E”) (together, “the Companies” and individually, the “Company”) hereby submit the costs associated with the implementation and operation of its CDG Net Crediting program for calendar years 2020 through 2025.
