NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS

(Issued December 31, 2025)

On December 11, 2025, Department of Public Service staff (DPS staff) filed a proposal recommending that Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., New York State Electric & Gas Corporation, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid, Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc., and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (the Joint Utilities) make various revisions to the calculation of the Demand Reduction Value (DRV) and Locational System Relief Value (LSRV) components of the Value of Distributed Energy Resources Value Stack. The revised DRV and LSRV components would be calculated based on the Marginal Cost of Service studies that the Joint Utilities included in the Distribution System Implementation Plans that they filed on June 30, 2025.¹ DPS staff also proposed that the Joint Utilities file draft LSRV tariffs containing non-price terms and conditions, including dispatchability and reliability, for comment by interested entities. Those draft tariffs should be filed by March 2, 2026, as noted below.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that interested entities are invited to submit initial comments on the DPS staff proposal and

supporting workpapers, by **March 2, 2026**. The Joint Utilities should file draft LSRV tariffs on March 2, 2026, with their initial comments. Responses to the initial comments and/or the Joint Utilities' draft LSRV tariff language should be filed by **March 23, 2026**.

Comments should be filed in both cases, electronically, by going to www.dps.ny.gov, clicking on "File Search" (located in the drop down menu under "Commission Files"), entering "15-E-0751" or "19-E-0283" in the "Search by Case Number" field, and then clicking on the "Post Comments" box located at the top of the page. All comments submitted in accordance with this Notice will be posted on the Department of Public Service's website. However, comments received after the deadlines may not be considered by the Commission.
