Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 4 of the *Order Adopting Enhanced Energy Affordability Policy and Directing Utility Filings* (the “Order”), issued by the New York State Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) on July 17, 2025 in the above referenced matters directed utilities, including New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (“NYSEG”) and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E”), (together the “Companies”), to file Enhanced Energy Affordability Program (“EEAP”) budgets for the period ending November 30, 2026.

The Order directed the Companies to increase Energy Affordability Program budget caps from 2 percent of total annual revenues to 2.5 percent of total annual revenues. Further, the Companies were directed to establish EEAP budget caps at 0.5 percent of total annual revenues. The Companies’ budgets are attached to this filing as Attachment A.
