



CON EDISON DEMAND RESPONSE PROGRAM APPLICATION

Con Edison administers peak shaving and contingency based demand response programs to manage energy usage from May to September. Demand Response programs are designed to cost effectively maintain reliable service on the Con Edison electrical distribution system.

Customers must submit an application as evidence of intent to provide load reduction in accordance with Con Edison procedures.

Enrollment in Commercial Demand Response Programs requires an interval meter. The customer who enrolled by the enrollment deadline must have a Con Edison-approved interval meter and communications in place and operational at least 30 days prior to program participation and communications in place and operational at least 1 day prior to program participation. The final date to start participating is July 1. For more information, visit www.conEd.com/DR.
