In its Order Instituting Proceeding, issued on April 18, 2024, in this proceeding, the Public Service Commission (Commission) directed Department of Public Service staff (Staff) to prepare a Grid Flexibility Study, the purpose of which is "to produce, assess, and report on the present status and future potential for flexible resources in New York's electric system." To address specific topics from the Grid Flexibility Study, Staff will be conducting a technical conference.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Staff will convene a technical conference, via WebEx, on November 15, 2024. The technical conference will start at 12:30 p.m. EDT and will conclude by 2:00 p.m. EDT. The purpose of this technical conference is to provide an overview of the methodology that is being used to assess the Distributed System Implementation Plan (DSIP) process and the anticipated deliverables. The review includes research of similar processes ongoing throughout the industry, a series of assessments of the current DSIPs and a review of Commission guidance for the DSIPs. Time will be reserved to answer questions from meeting attendees on the presented material.
